Since the Rod Hibbard Fund was established in 1994, over \$400,000 has been paid out to over 600 employees.

What is the Rod Hibbard Memorial Fund?

The Fund was established to provide emergency support to KenCrest employees who experience financial hardship due to medical, personal, or disaster situations. It is funded primarily through staff contributions.



Who was Rod Hibbard?

Rod was the founding director of KenCrest's Philadelphia residential programs. He worked for KenCrest from 1986 until his untimely death in 1994. At the center of his life was his love and devotion for his fellow staff members. In his will, he left a generous gift to the agency which was to be used to start the fund named in his memory, to help fellow staff in crisis.
