Since 1991, KenCrest has offered premier transitional care homes uniquely designed for infants, toddlers, and children with complex medical needs.

We are licensed by the Pennsylvania Department of Health as Intermediate Care Facilities. We accept infants and young children who are medically fragile and/or technology-dependent. This includes children with tracheotomies, central lines, oxygen and feeding tubes, chromosomal disorders, and neurological conditions.

## **What Sets KenCrest Apart**

Families can easily access the transitional care homes by public transportation, making visitation convenient. KenCrest encourages families to visit their children as often as they like. Additionally, the homes Child at Transitional Care Home are also in close proximity to several superior pediatric medical facilities including the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia.

Each home supports up to six children. Two nurses and one direct support professional staff the homes 24 hours a day, seven days a week. A medical director affiliated with A.I. DuPont Hospital in Wilmington, DE, leads our team of skilled nurses, physical therapists, occupation therapists, speechlanguage pathology personnel, and a social worker.

Our homes provide a comfortable setting where children can thrive in a community-based life model, participating in field trips, school programs, park visits, and other daily activities. KenCrest offers a warm, inviting environment that encourages and supports natural family involvement.
