

# **Staff Referral Reward\$**

#### What is the Staff Referral Reward\$

Current employees can earn a monetary reward for referring successful new hires!\*

If your referral is hired for a **full-time** permanent job and successfully completes his/her first 90-days of employment, you will receive a referral bonus payment.

#### Great referrals for these positions can earn you great rewards:

0	PA DSP and/or Program Manager Positions (ends 3/31)	\$1,000
0	PA Personal Outcome Champions (ends 3/31)	\$1,000
0	PA Community Connection Coaches (ends 3/31)	\$1,000
0	PA Employment Job Coaches (ends 3/31)	\$1,000
0	PA ELC Classroom Aides (ends 6/30)	\$1,000
0	PA ELC Associate Teachers (ends 6/30)	\$1,500
0	PA Teachers (ends 6/30)	\$2,000

#### How do I make a referral?

Tell your friends, relatives and neighbors about **full-time** permanent job openings at KenCrest and encourage them to apply. Your referral **must** name you (the employee) as their "Referral Source" on his/her online application. All current employees are eligible for the Referral Reward\$ (except VPs and Cabinet members).\*

### When do I receive my Referral Reward\$ bonus?

Your rewards bonus payment will be issued to you soon after your referral successfully completes their 90-day probationary period. HR Department collects information from the online job application and tracks 90 days from hire to process payments.\*\*
